THE LORD'S SUPPER is administered this morning. In it, we joyfully receive Christ's True Body and True Blood in, with, and under the bread and wine – for the forgiveness of sins, the strengthening of our faith, and the unity of the communicants. Since the Lord's Supper is an expression of our common confession of the Christian faith, we ask that only those persons who are confirmed members in good standing of a congregation of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod or of a church body in doctrinal fellowship with us, receive this Sacrament. Visitors are asked to visit with the Pastor prior to communing for the first time.

A **Guinea Mission Trip presentation** by Kirk & Kathy Molitor will be this afternoon at 3 PM in Kinsley at the 4-H building. If you plan on staying for the meal, please be sure to bring a covered dish sufficient for your family to share. Worship service will follow the meal.
